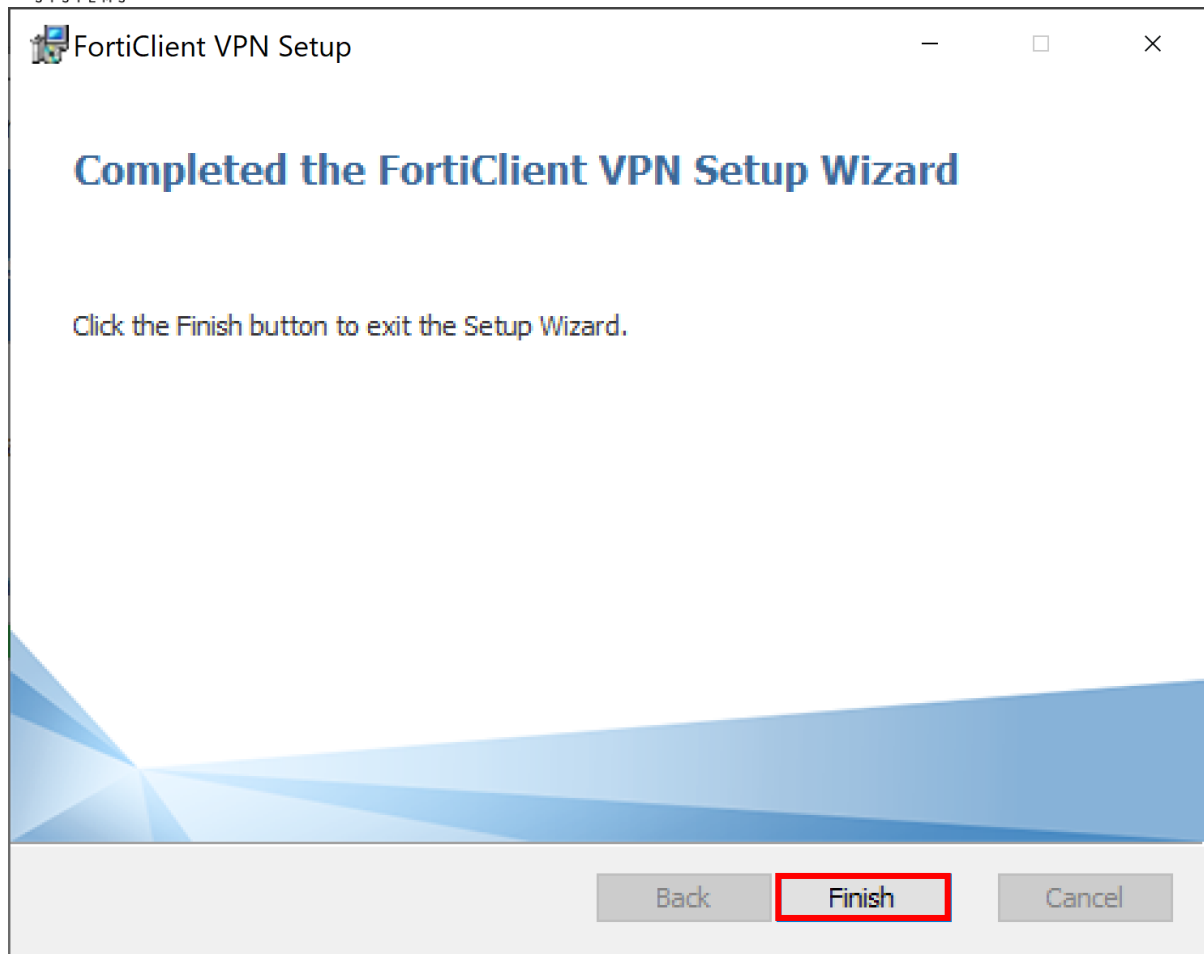
4. Once you see the Setup Wizard, mark the checkbox “Yes, I have read and accept the License Agreement” and click on Next.



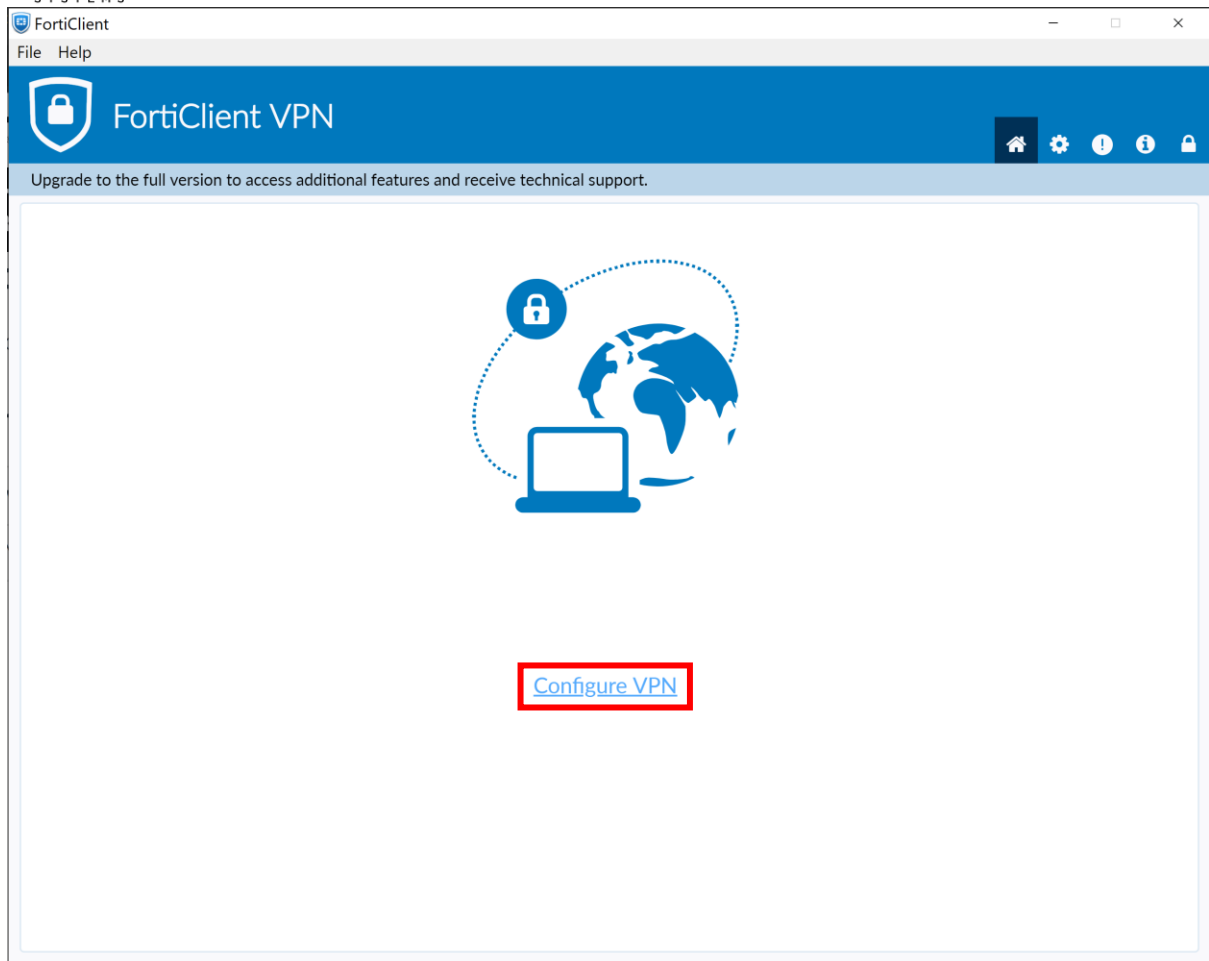
5. Leave the installation path as default. Click on Next.
